


Split is the second largest city in Croatia with near 180.000 inhabitants (around 300.000 with metropolitan area), the largest city on the Croatian Adriatic coast and the centre of Urban Agglomeration Split. As an important Croatian and Mediterranean cultural, university, economic and sport centre, Split has great spatial, professional, scientific and productive potential. City of Split, as a local government organization, has 12 departments employing 440 persons with annual budget of approximately 120 million euros. Its main objective is to represent all the citizens, improving the quality of their life, promoting the economic development of the local system. Main activities: public security, services for families and disadvantaged categories, public housing service, childhood and juvenile services, tourism promotion services, local public transport, sport, cultural managing, public lighting system, protection of environmental and cultural heritage. Department for International and EU funds has 21 members, but in accordance with the subject area of the project creates expert teams from other Departments for collaboration in implementation of the projects.

### SIPRO- Pilotaction in Ferrara

The aim of the pilot action is to support the Municipality of Ferrara to adopt smart energy tools aim at improving the energy performance of buildings also through the identification of financial tools; enlarge the dissemination and awareness raising about energy issues, start from the sample of households and citizens reached with CitiEnGov and involve more families During the implementation of the pilot action, the CitiEngov Energy dashboard has been extended to 45 buildings located in a portion of the district "Giardino" in Ferrara.

The scope of the work is to analyze, from an energy point of view, a series of buildings (45), mostly residential, within the same neighborhood. After the analysis phase, strategies and actions could be defined in future to favor the reduction of energy consumption for the entire city area identified.

### **OnePlace 3D redesigned**

The capitalization activities of our past 8 projects are finalised. The entire user interface of the OnePlace platform has a new layout in order to give access to past outcomes and solutions for Energy Efficiency of public buildings.

Moreover all 7 pilot actions are accessible in 3D within the 3DEMS module and user can query 3D buildings in order to retrieve, visualize and analyze the provided energy-related information. OnePlace will be the base



for the forthcoming pilot action activities and training events.



All partners present their progress and the following activities on the first day. Second day was used for a midterm review by the administrative authority.




# Participation at a public dissimination and communication event
