	On 19th and 20th of May, guided tours to the solar field were held for primary classes children from various schools. The solar thermal system, operated by FMI S.r.l., is a concentrating solar power plant that generates thermal energy to supply the district heating net with renewable energy addressed to industries connected of the surrounding area. The particular area around the solar field is an APEA (Ecologically Equipped Productive Area), where industries produce in a sustainable way, with a focus on waste, water management and energy efficiency.

	On 19 th and 20 th May, the children on the field trip were initially explained what a solar field is and how it works. At the end of an indoor explanation, they were then shown the two videos created by different primary classes, the first video created during the lockdown https://youtu.be/ET76rypzWSI and the second created in attendance, when the children were able to return to class https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=irzpJuLBkwM The videos created allowed the visiting children to better understand the difference between renewable and non-renewable energy sources in a simple and intuitive way. The visit continued outside, right in the solar field and in the thermal plant showing the machinery that regulates the whole process. At the end of the visit, the children were rewarded by giving each one a certificate of 'Renewable Energy Expert' and the mini solar toy forseen by the ENES-CE Pilot Action.
