

D.T2.2.2 Summary report of the administrative pilot test -FUA Katowice





The City of Katowice during the realisation of the project conducted many activities to raise resident's awareness of air quality. The administrative activities contain informing and education actions for the residents to reach the vulnerable groups. The administrative actions are related to the short-term action plan for the city of Katowice, and for the Silesian Region. The current short term action plan is associated with the guidelines contained in the "Air protection program for Silesia Region". The informing actions focuses on rising awareness about the air quality and searching for information about the air quality index and forecast for the next days, especially during winter season.

The implemented information activities include notifying as many inhabitants as possible about the state of air quality. The City used many information chanels such as: city website, social media profiles, text messegess from the special informing system, informations in local media and special presentations displayed on the monitors of the air quality monitoring system.

The educational activities provided during the project were: meetings with residents, training sessions for residents from vulnerable groups and public building administrators, outdoor events for residents. The educational activities focuses mainly on changing behaviours, rising awareness about ecology, what everyone can do to improve air quality. During realisation of the project part of educational activities were carried online due to pandemic situation in country.

One of the most important administrative actions were trainings for public building administrators that was carreid out dou to implementations of air quality monitoring system for the city and also update of the regional air protection program. During trainings public building administrators learned about the city and national air quality monitoring system, levels of informing ald smoke alert, changes in national and regional law. Trainings also contains information about anti-smoke local act and new job duties for police and municipal guard.

The documentation for Pilot tests in Katowice contains the main document with deliverable description for Pilot Tests – Katowice FUA.

The main document is divided in two parts. The first concerns legal aspects and procedures on the basis of which information tasks are carried out, as well as ad hoc mitigation measures in the event of the so-called smog alarm.

The second concerns the pilot investment task involving the installation of selected air pollution sensors in selected locations.

The Annex 2.2.2 Admin UMK PDK matrix contains the short-term action plan matrix (PDK) for the cityas the backbone for the DSS system for Katowice. Document contains the procedures for each level of pollution and engaged institutions.

The PDK matrix helps to divide duties between departments and how to act according to current level of pollution or forecast for the next days (esspecially weekends and national



holidays). PDK Matrix includes not only municipal institutions but also local media, universities, and health services as a part of crysis management plan and procedure in the city. It's planned to organise administrative trainings and test for municipal public buildings administrators frequently, update of contact list and inform them about mayor changes in procedures or law.
