Summary description of the implemented training measure(s), explaining the specific goal(s), target groups and transnational added value

The Municipality of Zugló has established a municipal platform within the framework of the AWAIR international project, which would promote research, training and awareness-raising activities on air quality and air quality in the agglomeration. In this context, it examines incineration regulations and the management of smog situations in all aspects, including cooperation between state and local government bodies, the role of authorities, the way in which smog alerts are ordered, possible measures and their enforcement. In the case of a period of poor air quality, in addition to developing cooperation, our topic is also informing the population, shaping attitudes and the uniform use of communication channels. We provided a 2-hour online training for current and future collaborating partners of the platform, in which they can learn the most important knowledge and communication tools on the topic of air quality.

The Municipalities' FUA on line training was attended by the technicians of the Administrations of the FUA. Because of the COVID 19 restrictions the meeting was held through the platform of the web. The main challenge of the training was to transfer knowledge and to provide tools for reading air quality information and for implementing mitigation and adaptation measures, developed with AWAIR project.

We invited the main experts to present each topic from the common AWAIR training concept. We made a certificate that they can download for themselves from canva. The tools we used: for online meeting-go to meeting, for test :sli.do for certificate: canva.

The participants also received a 15 pages summary.

The approach of this process can be adapted to other territories.

Sustainability of the training(s) and developed training material(s) and their transferability to other territories and stakeholders


The process of involving the FUA Municipalities can be replicated in other territories, through the use of information material produced by AWAIR, through the use of local mass media and with continuous contacts and updates with all the technicians and administrators involved. Small municipalities by networking with each other and with the Municipality of Budapest capital can implement actions that individually they would not be able to do efficiently. Through the Memorandum of Understanding signed by several Budapest ditricts and the cooperation of Budapest Capital and their commitment to improve the management for the SAPE will be carried on. Another important legacy of the project showed during the training , is the application of "Interreg SAPEs APP" whose promotion and use will be shared with the other municipalities. Zuglo also made a knowledge HUB available online for all the AWAIR Platform members. They can find there all the presentations of the FUA meetings, the policy recommendations, researches, and communication and awareness raising materials. I

We believe this training can be used for other stakeholders too for example teachers, social workers. The lesson we learnt is that there are so many misunderstandings and one training not able to change attitude towards air quality. We need to carry on and repeat the trainings in wilder public and other FUA members and provide ready-made communication materials for dissemination.
