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Summary

Within the CEUP2030 Project, the Project Partners were requested to reach all together 20 presentations/panel discussions on complementary public events. The total number was originally requested as 2 such appearances/ PP (10*2).

In the beginning of the project- 2020 March- the Partners agreed upon the requirements, and since then they have been continuously contributing to this deliverable. PBN as WPC Leader was also continuously monitoring PPs' input and in case some information/evidence might have missed they asked those from the respective PP. PBN also informed the Partners of the updates of this deliverable on every periodic Project Meeting.

By the end of the project, (04/2022) Partners fulfilled, and even overfulfilled the requested quantification target. All in all, PPs have **reached 24 presentations on complementary public events**. Every PP has contributed, but the distribution of contribution was not equal.

Clarification, and common agreement of the deliverable: In case PPs held a presentation on a complementary=thematically related project event (e.g: S3HubsinCE) where the topic was similar to CEUP, and CEUP appeared somehow (with logo in the ppt, and/or presenting the thematic activities of CEUP..) in their presentation, they could be counted as an excellent indicator here.
