1. Introduction

In order to support the diffusion of the knowledge contained in the circular economy starter kit developed with the project, the partners in the target regions did translate part of it in their national language. 2. Translated materials

The training concept for regional stakeholder groups encompasses the planned training activities targeting, in each of the target region for the project, the stakeholders groups involved in the definition of a circular economy strategy in the framework of the CITY CIRCLE project.

Croatian language

The partner DAN ensured the translation of part of the Starter Kit into a presentation in Croatian language. It was used two times in the framework of meetings with regional stakeholders:

1. 15.11.2019 - 15 stakeholders (32 participants)
2. 28.11.2019 - 9 stakeholders (19 participants)

German language

Translation of the starter kit.

Italian language

The partner APE FVG translated part of the Start Kit in a presentation in Italian language used initially in the context of a meeting with regional stakeholders. The meeting took place in Udine on 11 December 2019. 21 persons took part.

Slovak language

The partner TUKE drafted a presentation in Slovakian language building in the content of the Starter Kit. It was used first in the framework of a meeting with regional stakeholders on 12 February 2020. Seven persons took part.

Slovenian language

The partners Krnaj and e-Zavod drafted a presentation in Slovenian language building in the content of the Starter Kit. It was used first in the framework of a meeting with regional stakeholders on 16 January 2020.
