Summary description of the key features of the tool (developed and/or implemented) and of its transnational added value

The DLRs in Italian deal with the following topics: Smart Water Governance, Sustainable Water Management, Water Efficiency, Water Losses reduction, Rainwater management, Greywater recycling. The DLRs in Italian address the challenge of having a tool able to support the creation of a shared language and a shared knowledge base on circular water management in Italy. They are targeted at the personnel and stakeholders of the Italian municipalities, but also at the regional and national level to build integrated strategies at all levels of government.

The DLRs in Italian were built based on the DLRs in English previously produced in the project, adapting them to the Italian context according to the analysis of the main local peculiarities and priorities and on the suggestions of the Turin SG. The process included testing the training materials in Italian with the SG of the Turin FUA-and revising it according to the indications received.
