Consultancy, support, experience exchange, etc. in various fields of climate protection; **development of tools and campaigns**









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

WHAT IS CITY CYCLING ALL ABOUT?

Competition between cities for climate protection and to promote cycling

Every municipality (i.e. city, town/village, district/region) is invited to **participate**

➔ All in one: communication, planning and citizen participation tool for local authorities!

Local politicians/councillors as THE **decision-makers** for cycling are able to **experience their city by bicycle** whilst acting as **role models** at the same time





Aims to motivate more citizens to cycle more and more often, for work and during their free time















HOW DOES CITY CYCLING WORK?

Campaign period: May 1 to September 30

- Action phase within municipalities:
 - 21 consecutive days (free choice of the exact dates)

Those who live, work, belong to a club, or go to school/university in a participating city can join in

Councillors set up **teams** with citizens School classes, clubs, organisations, companies, etc. can form their own teams

Everyone can participate!

















HOW DOES CITY CYCLING WORK?

(cont'd)

Online cycle calendar to record kilometres or via **app**

Each participating city has its own sub-site/domain at city-cycling.org

MAIN PARTNERS



with specific information (contact details of local coordinators, opening/closing ceremony, offered cycle tours, etc.), statements from team captains, team overviews plus results...

Awards in three different categories for the best cities and local parliaments; prizes for the best local teams/cyclists within cities















WHAT IS A CYCLE STAR?



21 days on bike and "car-free" (public transport/train journeys are still allowed)

Specific terms and conditions apply for this special category:

If possible a **"local celebrity"**, e.g. (lord) mayor, councillor, head of department of the environment/ transport, etc. should volunteer to participate

➔ Again, politicians as role models!

Broad media coverage, media-effective 'storage' of the participant's car

Commitment to writing about their experiences in the **CITY CYCLING blog**



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RADAR! REPORTING PLATFORM

Cycling reporting platform

- **Optional** use by CITY CYCLING municipalities
- Municipal **planning tool for infrastructure** measures, can (at least) complement municipal road checks
- **Citizen participation tool:** municipalities are able to contact cyclists directly and vice versa
 - Cyclists feel that their concerns are taken seriously
- Municipalities are able to communicate (e.g. during CITY CYCLING in the following year) just which/how many measures have/will be implemented

Municipalities transparently demonstrate their commitment to cycling

HOW DOES RADAR! WORK?

Reports possible for the according municipalities in the respective territory/area of responsibility

Option of submitting reports online by adding an address/pin to the road map or via CITY CYCLING and RADar! apps (GPS!)

Only cyclists who have signed up for CITY CYCLING are able to submit reports/position pins

- Minimisation of "hoax reports"; manageable number of reporters
- Increase in participants; yet another reason to participate in CITY CYCLING

Reports can be submitted during the 21 CITY CYCLING days

➔ Reasonable time frame for municipalities

HOW DOES RADAR! WORK?

(cont'd)

Reports are emailed to a prearranged place (e.g. highways authority) for review and processing

Automatic and customised email transmission


Municipalities are free to decide whether reports and their processing status are visible to the general public

Positive feedback also possible

From 2016 on: RADar! can be offered beyond the 21 CITY CYCLING days on a separate platform/website \rightarrow Pilot phase possible

From 2017 on: RADar! available outside Germany

















WE'RE GOING INTERNATIONAL

From 2017 on: worldwide participation

- English website: city-cycling.org
- Identical rules of participation
- 20 % discount, if national languages is not German or English
- CITY CYCLING at the same time with partner cities
 - Competition "against" each other but together for the good cause
 - Strengthening/Deepening friendly relations to partner cities worldwide

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





WHAT MATERIAL/SERVICES DOES CLIMATE ALLIANCE OFFER?

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
