PROJECT

Development of an integrated concept for the deployment of innovative technologies and services allowing independent living of frail elderly.

The niCE-life project will foster social inclusion and care coordination of the elderly with cognitive medium-low deficits, including Alzheimer's and Parkinson's diseases and other chronic diseases. It will develop an innovative health care model by using progressive technologies such as sensor technologies, ICT and data analysis techniques, preventing frailty of the elderly, enhancing their quality of care and supporting independent living, social contacts and assistance after hospital discharges.
