	Mr. Márton Fabók (KESZ- community energy service) and Mr. Bence Kovács reported that the first renewable energy community investment in Hungary was realized just a few days before the ENES CE meeting. The 'Kazánház' energy community implemented a 36 kWp system on the rooftop of the community centre in Orczy street. The experts offered their knowledge and contribution for further energy community projects.	
	Ms. Maria Csikai, project manager of the ENES-CE Zugló presented the results and lessons learnt of the project implementation iz Zugló. She explained the difficulties in legal framework of energy community and underlined the focuses of the activities in Zugló: community building, engaging, and supporting local NGOs, awareness raising, and encouraging green lifestyle steps of citizens. The main outcome of the project is the multilateral cooperation agreement between the municipality, local NGOs, and businesses.
