### REVISED ENERGY PLAN OF ZUGLÓ

The SECAP of Budapest 14. District, Zugló Municipality entered in force in April 2019. However, the bi-yearly revision of the SECAP was scheduled for 2021, and in 2020 the city council decided to develop a local Climate Strategy with involvement of local citizens and other stakeholders. As the aim and content of the two documents are similar, avoiding redundancy in the activities of the Municipality, ENES-CE team decided to focus on support and contribute to the development of Climate Strategy document.

The Climate Strategy (financed by the Széchenyi 2020 Program KEHOP-1.2.1-18-2018-000333) document was finalized and entered into force in June 2021 and it is available on the project website:

- Contribution of the public questionnaire to select the most attractive pilot actions

Due to the development of the Climate Strategy document, the official revision of SECAP is scheduled for the second semester of 2022. Currently the data collection and background research are in progress.
