Scale up local initiatives

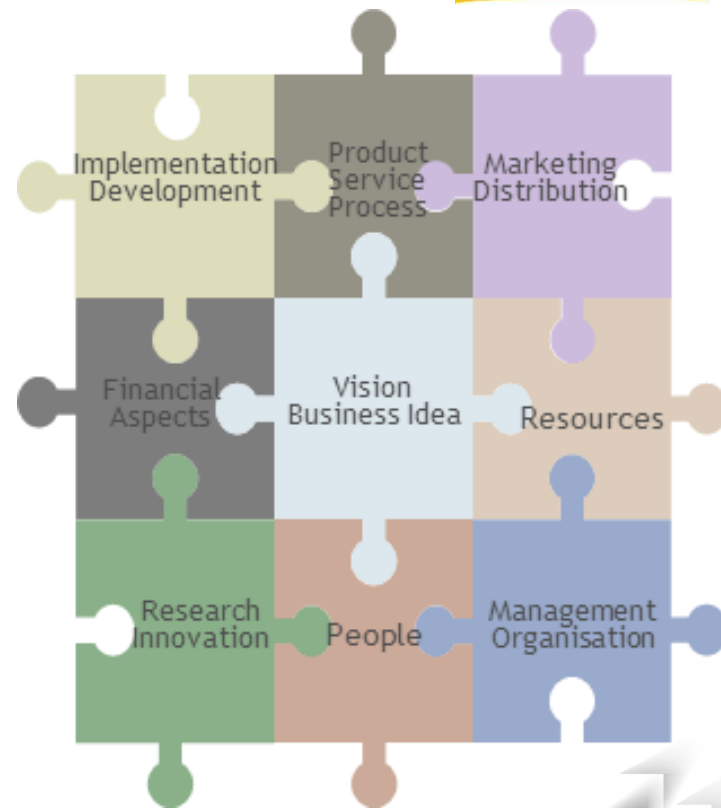
We need to adjust to lack of CE knowledge with proper approach
