A COMMON APPROACH FOR THE PILOT PROJECTS

In the first phase of DelFin project implementation, the DelFin partnership analyzed the current situation of social entrepreneurship in the partner countries (Croatia, Germany, Hungary and Italy) and based on this, developed a Toolbox of successful business support tools.

The Toolbox aims at the promotion of social entrepreneurship with a focus on funding & finance instruments.

At the following stage, the partners selected instruments of the developed Toolbox and combined them in pilot programs to develop recommendations on how to better support social entrepreneurs (SEs) in rural areas.

As the initial step of pilot project development, partners compiled a common approach for implementation of the pilot projects with the guidance and leadership of IFKA Public Benefit Non-profit Ltd.

This common approach is the "Joint Concept for Implementation of Pilots" (Joint Concept), which ensures the comparability, measurability, and transferability of pilot projects and their results.

The Joint Concept also ensures that project partners target rural territories on both regional and country levels. It also identifies the needs and problems to be tackled to support the development of the social enterprise ecosystems such as aging, depopulation, lack of infrastructure, awareness, and unclear understanding of social entrepreneurship, as well as weak SE ecosystems.


