## REPORT OF STUDY TOUR IN POLAND

### Executive summary

#### **27th – 30th of May 2019 – Study visit for students from winning school involved into project ENERGY@SCHOOL**

From 27th to 30th of May 2019 took place a study trip from winning school Scuola media Emaldi, from Fusignano in Italy.

A visit to Bydgoszcz was the main reward in the competition for students involved in the international ENERGY @ SCHOOL project. The main goal of the project is to effectively manage energy in school buildings. The study trip was aimed at increasing awareness of energy saving, through the presentation of installations related to renewable energy sources and modern energy-saving methods.

27th of May 2019 – arrival to Warsaw

First meeting with Representatives of Organisers of study trip

28<sup>th</sup> of May 2019 - Itinerary Mylhof – Rytel - Bydgoszcz

First point of this trip was a visit of hydro dam with water power plant situated in Mylhof. The participants had an opportunity to see the mechanism of action of water power plant and hydro dam.

Next step of study trip was a visit in Forest Agency in Rytel. The Deputy of Forester, Mr Mariusz Brunka presented in a very interesting way the level of devastation of the forest due to hurricane and also talked about rebuilding of forest stand.

29th of May 2019 – Bydgoszcz

Initial step was a visit in Municipal Waste Incineration Installation ProNatura limited liability company. Mr Łukasz Kowalski – Deputy of Head of Marketing and Social Communication Office – presented in a short introduction the mechanisms of Installation and show the guests around. Then the group went to one of the Bydgoszcz schools – Primary School No. 31 (School Team No.10). After greeting of School Principal, Mrs. Aleksandra Kuś, the students from Scuola media Emaldi from Fusignano presented their own city, schools and the ENERGY @ SCHOOL project. Then Mr Mateusz Buza, representing the Bydgoszcz City Hall, summarized the ENERGY @ SCHOOL project in the Bydgoszcz City and institutions subordinated to the city. An photovoltaic installation at Szkoła Podstawowa No.31 at ul. Karłowicz was also presented.

The next stage of the trip was a visit to the City Hall in Bydgoszcz, during which the Coordinator of the Energy Management Team of the City of Bydgoszcz, along with colleagues, guided the participants around the facility, and also talked about the functioning of the Office. The meeting with employees of the City Hall was completed on the Old Market Square, where one of the City's



attractions - Mr. Twardowski in the window of the tenement house was presented especially for the participants of the trip. The history of the City was told during the walk by guide.

The attraction of the last day of the visit was participation in the Italy - Japan match, played as part of the U-20 World Championship.

30<sup>th</sup> of May 2019 – departure from Warsaw

17 pupils and 3 teachers representing the school in the Italian town of Fusignano participated in the study trip. An organized study visit in addition to the presentation of technologies related to renewable energy also provided the opportunity to exchange views and experiences between participants of the ENERGY @ SCHOOL project in Poland and Italy.
