Limits and difficulties we encounter

THE HARDEST PART: PARTNERS ENGAGEMENT

- Time is the most valuable resource: we need to optimize how we spend our partners' time, especially for clinicians, whose time is expensive and extremely valuable to the society
- Partners lack the personnel resources that can work as a constant contact point with the Cluster and with the other partners.
- Multiple Working Groups on multiple topics require a great effort in order to be efficient and up to date with the everchanging requests of the society and of the market.

LISTENING TO THE NEEDS:

- Research Organizations and SMEs' products and services hardly reach the market. Technological Transfer is even more complicated due to the changes in the Regulatory Requirements.
- O Scientifically sound Clinical trials must be designed: SMEs often don't have the competence and the resources to do so; they don't have the possibility to fail.
- O Clinicians need to speed up the TT process to bring improvements in the clinical practice.

CO-DESIGN A SOLUTION:

- Within an Interregional Project Action Plan design (*Medtech4Europe*)
- Along with Lombardy's General Directorate Research and Innovation
- Collecting ideas from our Partners

PROJECT PROPOSAL:

- Creation of a Clinical Trials Competence Centre with representatives from industry, clinics, society and policy makers.
- The center will work as a lighthouse, giving directions and suggestions to design clinical trials.
