<b>Output of the activity</b>	<p><u>Focus of the discussion</u></p> <p>The main point of the meeting was to discuss the potential issues that need to be addressed during the creation of the Regional Action Plan.</p> <p>The meeting started with a general discussion of prominent technologies in advanced manufacturing and their lack in SMEs of certain industrial sectors. Many issues were raised during the conversation and the most pressing matters to address emerged, such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• low investment in R&amp;D by local SMEs,</li> <li>• low level of IoT competence and the lack of highly skilled staff,</li> <li>• SMEs unwillingness to share information with other companies and cooperate.</li> </ul> <p>All of the above concerns were decided to be addressed and some actions have been proposed to tackle these issues:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• increasing awareness of Advanced Manufacturing Processes, which could help local SMEs,</li> <li>• providing examples on how to apply new technologies or develop existing technologies into AVM technologies,</li> <li>• offering trainings for employees in the fields of IIoT and other Advanced Technologies,</li> </ul>
