	Eva Breuer from LP Biz-Up welcomed all attendees and in particular the 2 new members of the AVM board: Wolfgang Güttel and Rafal Trzaska.	
	The following topics were discussed within this meeting:	
	Sustainability of trainings - VHB

	For the first topic of the meeting, LP Biz-Up showed some impressions of the advanced training webinars, that are hosted at the VHB (Virtuelle Hochsschule Bayern).	
	Until that day, already more than 100 participants have finished one of the five courses with a VHB certificate.	
	The sustainable use of the developed InnoPeer AVM curriculum was discussed as second point. LP Biz-Up presented 4 different scenarios for that purpose. Additionally, <i>P.Rübig</i> suggested, that the curriculum can also be used for company-internal trainings, especially the advanced trainings can be used to train staff member all over the world.	
	B. Hatvan (subcontractor CPU) presented the Strategy for the sustainable institutionalization of the AVM Advisory Board – in the form of a think tank, which could serve e.g. as advisors for future projects of PPs. The AB members were asked for their comments on that approach:	
	 W. Güttel: The think tank is a very good idea. He suggests, that in a face to face meeting, the board members set the guidelines for their further cooperation and to closely talk about the expectations of the SME and the InnoPeer AVM (and future projects') project partners. E. Bressan: The think tank is an interesting proposal. Especially in the current situation with the lock-down of the economy due 	

to COVID-19, the SME need support to manage the re-start phase to the best. For this purpose the think tank could be useful.

R.Trzaska: It is a good proposal and the just mentioned approach for supporting SME in the re-start phase is a very good opportunity.

P.Rübig: It is a very good idea to form such an international think tank. He is definitely ready to contribute to it as well as giving advice to further projects and initiatives.

M.Fink: May I please reinforce my statement in favour of a sustained cooperation of the board and the participants in this project in the form of an international think tank. I am convinced that such an institutionalized body can facilitate knowledge exchange and joint action beyond the project duration. Also follow up projects can be enabled, because the think tank proofs a track record of collaboration that is independent from a specific funding. This in turn documents the intrinsic motivation of the members of the think tank.

E.Mazgajczik (WRUT) presented briefly the agenda of the final conference and invited all AVM Board members to participate in that online event on 19th May 2020.

Finally, LP Biz-Up thanked all participants for their contributions.
