### DIGITAL PLATFORM

- The online tool specifically designed for the patients discharged from hospital
- Designed to make the care of patients more efficient (by allowing a quicker way of sharing data about patients what makes the care quicker, better planned and more precise, especially when cooperation between social and health services is needed).

## Digital platform for frail care



“ The Care for frail is a digital platform designed by University Hospital Olomouc. The developed tool is based on practical experience from the Bologna eCare network. The platform was tested in the care center in Petržalka Bratislava and by the patients of St. Cyril and Methodius Hospital (University Hospital Bratislava). ”

### MAIN GOAL OF THE TOOL

- Making the care of patients more efficient by allowing a quicker sharing of data about the patients discharged from hospitals
- To save time of professionals (nurses), who can actually provide care instead of travelling throughout the district with physical documentation (deemed as not very safe).

### BENEFITS

- Empowering of frail elderly by giving them tool to be used at home with or without help of family
- Speeding up work with patient data, faster and secure data sharing with affected subjects (home care, nursing services, social care services)
- Secure and fast data sharing with GP - timesaving solution for general practitioners
- Relief for care givers from the patient's environment, who have easier access to medical documentation for the needs of further care, handling of state benefits, etc.
- Time of health and social workers can be used for patient care instead of traveling with papers.
