The NCA was established in 2008 and currently associates twenty leading cluster organisations (representing altogether some 450 members, i.e. enterprises, educational and research institutions) and eight cluster supportive institutions, such as a university, regional development agencies, innovation infrastructure bodies, and consultants. The NCA strives for creating conditions for effective utilization of cluster merits in accordance with the development policy of the European Commission (cluster management excellence, intelligent specialization of regions, inter-cluster cooperation support for the EU competitiveness, etc.) and provides promotion, education, consultancy and awareness building activities for the member cluster organisations.

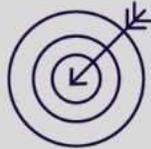
KETGATE POINT SERVICES

SME SERVICE #1:

EVALUATING THE INNOVATION CAPACITY OF YOUR COMPANY

SME SERVICE 1: EVALUATING THE INNOVATION CAPACITY OF YOUR COMPANY



GOALS: To suggest and advice how to improve innovation strategy, to valorise potentialities and to overcome weaknesses. To identify the best approach to serve companies in coherence with "innovation maturity".



In each KETGATE point BA (Business Advisor) is responsible to perform the innovation assessment. Performing a company visit, allows the BA to collect profound insights on the businesses & infrastructure on the company.



THE METODOLOGY: Innovation performance based on a structured methodology allows BAs to collect data, asses the company's performance and possibly benchmark the individual outcomes with the performance of the other companies.

Fine-tuned tools ready to assess innovation generate automatically graphics, showing the company "position" accordingly to the specific scores and indicators.

The resulting repots and the recommendations for improvement are stricly connected with benchmarking criteria and the methodology behind each specific tool.
