About this document

The main aim of this document is to collect and list information about the funding opportunities on EU, national and regional level. For this purpose, each project partner analysed the investment and funding opportunities referring to their country and region based on an input template prepared by EMFIE. With the help of the input template the information collected is comparable regarding each partner.

The main challenges

The main challenge in preparing this document and collecting information about the current investment and funding opportunities was the fact that the current programming period is almost over, thus the calls open are very limited, and we have no information about the possible calls and opportunities from the next programming period (2021-2027). Some partners highlighted that at this specific point in time, with the new cohesion policy being discussed, there is quite some uncertainty as to what opportunities for funding will actually emerge.

Analysing the available EU level, national, regional funding opportunities, in some cases the project partners indicated that they could not provide information, thus on that level no open calls are available.

It is also a problematic question to find investment and funding opportunities that can be used to help SMEs and RI consultants to continue their work and the ROSIE project.

Regarding that the funding and investment possibilities concerning responsible innovation are limited, partners tried to find open calls and opportunities that has a relationship with some elements or dimensions of responsible innovation (eg. stakeholder engagement, science education, ethics, etc.). Thus most of the funding and investment possibilities listed in this document can be used indirectly regarding responsible innovation.

Project partners tried to find some other projects that can serve as benchmark examples and best practices was also discovered that we can use or adapt in the future. From these examples we can learn or adapt some elements and also the results could be used.

Future Plans

Most of the project partners could not mention any plans for the future after ROSIE project ends. The uncertainty and the lack of information about the next programming period was the reason behind it. *“As the current programming period is almost over, and we do not know too much about the opportunities of the next programming period starting in 2021,*



so it is not easy to make plans for the future. We hope that the next programming period will bring great opportunities to SMEs and RI Consultants too.”

Most of the partners highlighted that they would like to accomplish their plans which has been explained in detail in the RI Road Maps. For instance, the Slovakian partner explained that *“The local action plan for Slovenia will be rolled out through the Call for proposals for raising the competences of leading tourist destinations and developing tourist offer in leading tourist destinations in 2020 and 2021 to which the Public institution for tourism Nova Gorica and Vipava Valley will apply. MONG is one of the funders of this institution and will take an active role in project design and implementation, also in terms of using RI tools and promoting responsible innovation in tourism through UN's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)”*.

Most of the project partners insisted on that they wait for more information about the possibilities of the next programming period to make plans for the future.
