### Summary description of the implemented training measure(s), explaining the specific goal(s) and target groups

The additional training on Management plan development was held on 4. September 2018 in Ljubljana, Slovenia. Altogether 6 participants were trained.

Effective training activities were conducted in order to provide the necessary understanding and information as well as to engage actively participants in the training. Prior to the training, the local partners distributed to all participants the documents on Management plan for Ljubljana-Ig and themes of interest. Then the trainer gave the evaluation of the documents according to defined criteria (completeness, clearness and comprehensibility, focus on strategic objectives and forma requirements). Afterwards, local partners from Ljubljana-Ig presented their expertise in Management plan development. Finally, an active discussion about Ljubljana-Ig case study was performed, concrete suggestions for problem solving were defined. The discussion allowed exchange of transnational experience and knowledge.

The presented training supported the project partner to better understand the methodology and to finalize the groundwater Management plan.

Higher education and research (PP9), infrastructure and public service provider (PP10), local public authority (AP16 and AP20) were targeted groups involved in the training, since they are the responsible for the development and application of the Management plan.

### Expected impact and benefits of the trainings for the concerned territories and target groups

The training was specially tailored according to local needs and challenges of the pilot in Ljubljana. The training was held in local Serbo-Croatian language, which is considered as a special benefit of the training. This enabled the contribution of more participants on a local level and their inclusion in the project.

The concept of the Management plan for Ljubljana-Ig was discussed; themes of interest were defined by local partner and distributed prior to the training. The training gave valuable suggestions for further steps, which shall improve the efficiency of working process.

### Sustainability of the training(s) and developed training material(s) and their transferability to other territories and stakeholders

This training methodology proved to be an adequate for thoroughly discussing and evaluating the Management plan. The presentations, discussions and material were performed on local language, which enabled an involvement of crucial parties for the development of the Management plan.

In this way, the partner successfully finalized Management plan, based on the instructions gained at the training. This improved the efficiency of working process.

### Lessons learned from the development and implementation of training measures and added value of transnational cooperation

Applied training measures were efficient and successful in reaching the set goals of this training. Combined measures of lecture style and interactive approach gave satisfactory results. The participants discussed Ljubljana-Ig case study, jointly suggesting solutions and exchanging experiences. Therefore, the working process of local partners shall be improved in future.

The training enabled a special focus on the practical examples in the pilot site Ljubljana-Ig. The training was specially tailored according to local needs and challenges.
