

Science Fair, 7-9 June 2018

For the fourth year now, the Czech Academy of Sciences organized the biggest popular – educational event of its kind in the Czech Republic – Science Fair, the way how to bring the science to everyday life to wide public.

The Institute of Archaeology of CAS, Prague showcased archaeology and technology with the freshness that would be expected nowadays. It focused on using of 3D in archaeology, on virtual and augmented reality. The visitors could appear in the past. They had an immersive experience with mediaeval royal town of Slaný and the Celtic oppidum Závist during the 2<sup>nd</sup> century BC via 3D glasses. They could realize the origin of 3D historical reconstructions in Lumion and SketchUp software. On this occasion was presented the international project VirtualArch – Visualize to Valorize – For a better utilisation of hidden archaeological heritage in Central Europe, granted for 2017 – 2020, aiming on visualisation of the hidden archaeological sites. Different 8 European archaeological sites will be visible thanks to mobile app.
