

GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE STRATEGY




Tri-Border Region CZ-DE-PL

- Two fields of action:
 - Oreation and enhancement of urban green spaces
 - Restoration of watercourses, floodplains and catchment areas
- Strategic aims of the strategy:
 - Strengthen health and quality of life
 - Create environmental education opportunities
 - Create opportunities for recreation and promote tourism
 - Protect and increase biodiversity
 - Establishment and adapted management of GI as a contribution to sustainable land & soil management as well as agriculture & forestry
 - Use GI for climate change mitigation & adaptation and disaster prevention




